Northland College Eligibility Requirements, Policies, and Application Procedures for Round River Conservation Studies

Eligibility Requirements

To participate in a Round River Conservation Studies program, students must have:

- 1) sophomore, junior, or senior standing during the term(s) in which they participate in the Round River program;
- 2) earned "Good" academic standing in the semester prior to their participation in the Round River program;
- 3) no incomplete grades from terms prior to their participation in the Round River program;
- 4) no academic or financial holds on their student account.

Policies

The following policies govern the Northland College partnership with Round River:

- 1) Participation in Round River programs is open to students studying in any academic area;
- 2) Students are responsible for paying tuition and fees for Round River Programs directly to Round River;
- 3) If eligible students wish to apply federal or state financial aid to the costs of their Round River program and to earn academic credit for their program, they must a) complete Northland's "Round River Conservation Studies Application to Participate" form; b) pay Northland an off-campus credit fee of \$70 per credit; c) complete a "Student Account Refund Form," and d) complete and submit the "Round River Special Program Registration Form" prior to beginning the off-campus program [Note: Students are not eligible to apply Northland College scholarships, grants, or aid awards to the cost of Round River programs, with the exception of grants made through the McLean International Travel Fund].
- 4) Students planning to participate in a Round River program assume responsibility for completion of required paperwork with Round river and for notifying the Northland College Registrar's Office of final enrollment plans:
- 5) It is the student's responsibility to immediately notify the Northland College Registrar's Office if any changes are made to their schedule once the Round River program begins. If a student withdraws from or leaves a Round River program during the semester, or decides not to attend at the last minute, the Registrar's Office must be notified immediately. Failure to do so may have significant financial consequences.

	Notify the Northland College Round River Program Advisor, Sarah Johnson, of your interest in Round River and ask any questions that you may have about the program.
	Complete the Northland College "Application to Participate Form."
	Meet with and secure the signature of your academic advisor.
	Submit the "Application to Participate Form" to the Round River Program advisor for final approval no later than October 1 st for Winter Semester programs and no later than March
	1 st for Summer and Fall Semester programs.
	Prepare & Submit an application for a McLean International Travel Grant, if you wish. (For furthe details, contact Michaela Wickman at mwickman@northland.edu .)
Aft	er receiving final approval from the Round River Program Advisor
	Prepare and submit an application to Round River Conservation Studies. (The application may be found at www.roundriver.org)
Aft	er being accepted to a program by Round River
	Make appropriate deposit and tuition payments directly to Round River.
	Pay Northland College the appropriate off-campus credit fee of \$70 per credit.
	Complete a "Student Account Refund Form."
	Complete a Round River Special Program Registration Form and submit to the Registrar's Office as soon as possible.
	Immediately notify the Registrar's office if you make any changes to your plans or decide not to participate in the Round River program for which you have registered.
